The safety regulations were reviewed regarding: substance abuse and alcohol testing programs; maintaining complete driver qualifications, especially medical examination certificates, and the hours of service regulations. The vehicle maintenance, inspection and repair regulations were reviewed including the need for the company to keep current their periodic (annual) vehicle inspections. I conducted level 7 inspections for six new passenger vans the company has purchased and plans on using in the
