This company is a new entrant requesting passenger carrier authority in the Seattle metro area. The company has operated in throughout Hawaii for over ten years. The company is well versed in the safety regulations and has undergone DOT compliance reviews and received satisfactory ratings.

17. Findings:

I provided technical assistance to president Cecil Morton and Jack Roemer CFO for Speedishuttle Washington LLC. The safety regulations were reviewed regarding: substance abuse and alcohol testing programs; maintaining complete driver qualifications, especially medical examination certificates, and the hours of service regulations. The vehicle maintenance, inspection and repair regulations were reviewed including the need for the company to keep current their periodic (annual) vehicle inspections. I conducted level 7 inspections for six new passenger vans the company has purchased and plans on using in the

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proposed service. Each vehicle checked free of defects and the completed inspections have been uploaded to the federal database via Aspen.
