



and at that point will become unavailable to the other carrier. The Commission adopts these conditions and, for clarity, attaches them to this order as Appendix A.

5 The result is a grant of authority to both applicants. This result enhances diversity of suppliers, affords incentives to begin service, and allows comprehensive service to the public.

**ORDER**

6 THE COMMISSION ORDERS That the Initial Order is affirmed and adopted for purposes of this proceeding. In so doing, the Commission orders:

7 The Commission grants Application No. B-78937 of Dutchman Marine, LLC, as set out in paragraph 67 of the Initial Order, conditioned as specified in paragraphs 69 and 70 of the Initial Order.

8 The Commission will issue a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity as set out in Appendix B to this order to Dutchman Marine, LLC, d/b/a Lake Washington Ferry Service, granting the authority specified herein.

9 The Commission grants Application No. B-78946 of Seattle Harbor Tours Limited Partnership, as specified in paragraph 67 of the Initial Order, conditioned as specified in paragraphs 69 and 70 of the Initial Order.

10 The Commission will revise and reissue Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. BC-124 of Seattle Harbor Tours Limited Partnership to read as set out in Appendix C, attached to this Order, granting the authority specified herein.
