ADOPTION OF TARIFFS

Effective April 1, 2011, Qwest Corporation registered the fictitious name CenturyLink QC. Effective August 8, 2011, Qwest Corporation began operating under the name CenturyLink QC. As such, Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC* hereby adopts, ratifies, and makes its own, in every respect as if the same had been originally filed by it, all schedules, rules, notices, concurrences, schedule agreements, divisions, authorities or other instruments whatsoever, filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission by Qwest Corporation prior to August 8, 2011.

By this notice, Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC* also adopts and ratifies all supplements or amendments to any of the above schedules, etc., which Qwest Corporation has heretofore filed with said Commission.

CenturyLink, Inc., has filed a complaint in U.S. District Court for the Western District of Washington, Case No. 2:11-CV-00633 (Complaint) challenging certain portions of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) Order 14 in Docket UT-100820 (Order 14), approving the acquisition of Qwest Communications International Inc. by CenturyTel, Inc., subject to the companies' acceptance of the conditions specified in that order. The Company's continued use of the d/b/a "CenturyLink QC*" is subject to the Court's decision in the Complaint and any subsequent judicial review of, or Commission action in response to, that decision. By permitting the Company to use the d/b/a "CenturyLink QC*," the Commission does not waive any position it has taken or may take in response to the Complaint, including but not limited to taking the position that any judicial decision invalidating any part of Order 14 must result in a remand to the Commission to determine whether, and if so under what substitute conditions, the Commission should approve the transfer of control of Qwest Corporation to CenturyLink, Inc.

1. APPLICATION AND REFERENCE

1.1 APPLICATION OF TARIFF

- A. This Tariff contains regulations, terms, conditions, rates and charges applicable to the provision of Carrier Common Line, Switched Access Service, and other miscellaneous services, hereinafter referred to collectively as service(s), provided by Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC*, hereinafter referred to as the Company. The tariffed and regulated services offered herein by Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC*, whether under that name or the trade or brand name CenturyLink, are subject to the terms and conditions of this Tariff.
- B. The provision of such service by the Company as set forth in this Tariff is specifically intended to provide exchange network access to customers as follows:
 - 1. Interexchange Carriers, who provide service between local calling areas, must purchase services from this Tariff for their use in furnishing their authorized intrastate telecommunications services to end user customers, and for operational purposes directly related to the furnishing of such services.
 - 2. Any customer, including but not limited to telecommunications companies, may purchase certain services from this Tariff for their own or administrative use, as specified in other sections of this Tariff. Services provided for a customer's own or administrative use may be subject to the rates and charges of other tariffs of the Company.
- C. The provision of such services by the Company as set forth in this Tariff does not constitute a joint undertaking with the customer for the furnishing of any service.
- D. The regulations, rates and charges contained in this Tariff, are in addition to the applicable regulations, rates and charges specified in other tariffs of the Company.
