- 1 On March 4, 2013, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued Penalty Assessment TE-130198 against Excalibur Limousine, LLC. (Excalibur) in the amount of \$1,800, alleging violations of WAC 480-30-071, which requires Charter and Excursion companies to file annual safety reports with the Commission by December 31 each year, and WAC 480-30-076, which requires such companies to pay regulatory fees annually on that date.
  
- 2 On March 11, 2013, Excalibur filed with the Commission a request for hearing stating that it has filed its 2012 safety report with the Commission. Excalibur further states that since it was no longer in business prior to the end of 2012 that it didn't think it had to send in the safety report.
  
- 3 On March 25, 2013, Commission Staff (Staff) filed a response stating that it does not support mitigating the \$1,800 penalty assessment. Staff explains that as of March 13, 2013, Excalibur has failed to complete the annual safety report. Staff also states that Excalibur operated in 2012 and the company's permit remains active. Staff concludes that Excalibur also received penalties for failing to comply with WAC 480-30-071 in 2011.
  
- 4 Pursuant to RCW 34.05.482 and WAC 480-07-610, the Commission determines that a brief adjudicative proceeding is appropriate for determining whether the alleged violations of WAC 480-30-071 and 480-30-076 occurred and, if so, whether the penalty should be mitigated.

5 **THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That it will hold a brief adjudicative proceeding in this matter at 10:00 a.m., on Friday, April 26, 2013, in Room 108, First Floor, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington.**

6 The record in this case will consist of any documents regarding the matter that are considered by or prepared for the presiding officer for the brief adjudicative proceeding and a transcript of any oral statements given at the hearing, which statements will be given under oath.

7 Written notice of any other stage in the proceeding or other formal proceedings that the Commission may deem appropriate will be given during the course of this case. The Commission will provide at its offices in Olympia, Washington, copies of documents in the current record for use by the parties or others who may want to review them.

8 Parties wishing to submit any other documents for consideration at the brief adjudicative proceeding must file with the Commission a list enumerating and describing any such documents **no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, April 19, 2013**, and bring an original and three (3) copies to the hearing. Filing shall be in accordance with WAC 480-07-140 and – 145.

9 **THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE that any party who fails to attend or participate in the brief adjudicative proceeding set by this Notice, or any other stage of this proceeding, may be held in default under RCW 34.05.440 and WAC 480-07-450.**
