Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on May 28, 2014, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Lowper Incorporated in the amount of \$1000 for violation of WAC 480-110-505, which requires water companies to file an annual report with the Commission by May 1 each year. Lowper Incorporated failed to file its annual report for 2013, resulting in a penalty of \$1000. The Commission sent Lowper Incorporated a Second Notice on June 25, 2014, and a Final Notice on July 26, 2014.

The Commission has not received the \$1000 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$1000 balance.
