Dear Mr. Johnson:

Please find attached revised tariff page revisions for G-60 Tariff Number 27 for Fiorito Enterprises, Inc & Rabanco Companies (dba Kent-Meridian Disposal Company, Republic Services of Kent, & Allied Waste Services of Kent). This proposed change in the tariff reflects the change in the commodity credit for residential customers in the Service Areas defined in Appendix A from a credit of \$0.138 to a debit of \$0.092 per month and for multifamily customers, from a credit of \$0.04 to a credit of \$0.138 per yard. Due to the volatility of the current recycling market conditions, Republic Services is requesting a waiver from WAC 480-70-351 (2) and requesting to use the value of the most recent six-month historical period in estimating the revenue for the next six months. We are asking that this rate become effective on February 1, 2019 – July 31, 2019.
