Dear Mr. Johnson:

On May 17, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (commission) assessed a \$1,775 penalty in Docket TV-190111 against Whidbey Logistics LLC d/b/a Whidbey Moving and Storage (Whidbey or company) for violations of Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-15-555, Criminal Background Checks for Prospective Employees; WAC 480-15-560, Equipment Safety Requirements; and WAC 480-15-570, Driver Safety Requirements.

On May 20, 2019, Whidbey contacted commission staff (staff) to request a payment plan for the \$1,775 penalty. On May 28, 2019, staff and the company came to a mutual agreement on a proposed payment plan consisting of 11 monthly payments of \$150 each month, and a final payment of \$125, as follows:
