NOTICE CANCELLING BRIEF ADJUDICATIVE PROCEEDING

TO ALL PARTIES:

On February 1, 2022, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Notice of Intent to Cancel Permit as a Household Goods Carrier; Notice of Brief Adjudicative Proceeding; Setting Time for Oral Statements (Notice of Intent to Cancel) in Docket TV-220048. The Notice of Intent to Cancel informed Moving Art (Moving Art or Company) that the Commission would cancel the Company's permit effective March 16, 2022, unless the Company obtained Commission approval of a safety management plan prior to that date. The Notice of Intent to Cancel also scheduled a brief adjudicative proceeding for March 9 at 10 a.m.

On March 8, 2022, Commission staff (Staff) contacted the presiding officer to inform the Commission that Moving Art had submitted a safety management plan that Staff believes is acceptable. Staff requested that the Commission cancel the scheduled brief adjudicative proceeding and decide the matter on a paper record. Staff further stated that the Company waives its right to a hearing.

The Commission finds good cause to cancel the brief adjudicative proceeding currently set for March 9, 2022, and to decide this matter on a paper record.
