RE: *In the Matter of the Penalty Assessment Against A & G Brothers General Construction, in the Amount of \$1,000,*  
Docket DG-230173

TO ALL PARTIES:

On September 29, 2022, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) assessed a \$1,000 penalty (Penalty Assessment) against A & G Brothers General Construction (A & G or Company) for a violation of RCW 19.122.055(1)(a). The Penalty Assessment provided the Company with the opportunity to suspend, and ultimately waive, an \$800 portion of the penalty subject to the conditions that: a) A & G pay \$200 of the penalty amount; b) A & G employees responsible for excavation complete National Utility Contractors Association (NUCA) Dig Safe Training within 12 months of the date of the Penalty Assessment; c) A & G submit documentation of attendance of Dig Safe training within 5 days of attendance; and d) A & G not commit any additional violations of RCW 19.122 within 12 months following the Penalty Assessment.

On April 14, 2023, the Commission received notification from A & G that the company accepted the Commission's offer to suspend an \$800 portion of the penalty subject to the stated conditions.

On April 21, 2023, the Company paid \$200 towards the penalty.

On August 29, 2024, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that the Company had complied with all of the conditions and recommended that the Commission waive the suspended \$800 portion of the penalty and close the docket.

The Commission agrees that A & G has complied with the conditions set forth in the Penalty Assessment. The suspended \$800 portion of the penalty is thus waived, and this docket is closed.
