**NOTICE CANCELLING HEARING**

RE: *In the Matter of the Investigation of Industry Movers, Inc., For Compliance with WAC 480-15-555, WAC 480-15-560, WAC 480-15-570, and WAC 480-15-590, Docket TV-230785*

TO ALL PARTIES:

On October 3, 2023, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Penalty Assessment of \$600 against Industry Movers, Inc. (Industry Movers or Company).

The next day, in the same docket, the Commission issued a Notice of Intent to Cancel; Notice of Brief Adjudicative Proceeding; Setting Time for Oral Statements (NOIC) against Industry Movers. The NOIC, among other things, scheduled a brief adjudicative proceeding (BAP) for November 14, 2023.

On October 12, 2023, Company responded to the Penalty Assessment by admitting to the violations and requesting mitigation of the fees associated with violations of WAC 480-15-555.

On November 3, 2023, Commission staff (Staff) informed the presiding administrative law judge, by email, that Company had submitted a Safety Management Plan (SMP) which Staff reviewed and found acceptable. Further, Staff indicated that all contested issues had been

resolved by agreement of the parties – including a mitigated fee amount under an agreed upon payment plan. Staff requested that the Commission cancel the hearing.

The parties appear to have reached a full settlement in principle. *See* WAC 480-07-730. The Commission finds good cause to cancel the hearing currently set for November 14, 2023.

**THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the hearing set for November 14, 2023, at 1:30 p.m. is cancelled. The Commission will decide this matter on a paper record.**
