Commission Staff's Response to Request for Payment Arrangement

Dear Mr Killip:

On November 14, 2024, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a penalty assessment against Lemyn's Legacy Inc. d/b/a Spokane Party Bus, (Spokane Party Bus or Company) in the amount of \$6,700 for violations of Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-30-221, which adopts Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations (49 C.F.R.) Part 391 – Qualifications of Drivers and Part 395 – Hours of Service of Drivers.

On December 3, 2024, the Company submitted its application for mitigation of the penalties.

On December 20, 2024, the Commission entered Order 01, which suspended a \$3,500 portion of the penalty for a period of two years before being waived, subject to conditions. Order 01 required the Company to pay the \$3,200 portion of the penalty that is not suspended within 10 days or enter into a mutually agreeable payment arrangement with Staff.

On December 20, 2024, Commission staff (Staff) and Spokane Party Bus came to a mutual agreement on a proposed payment plan, as follows:

Staff recommends the Commission grant the Company's request for payment arrangements. Spokane Party Bus is aware that if it fails to pay any installment by the due date, the entire remaining balance, including the suspended penalty, will immediately become due and payable without further Commission order.
