Re: UG-250710 - Schedule 220: Special Rate Adjustment - Mist Recall - Replacement Pages - DO NOT REDOCKET

Dear Mr. Killip:

On September 15, 2025, Northwest Natural Gas Company, dba NW Natural (NW Natural or Company) filed tariff revisions in the above-mentioned docket with an effective date of November 1, 2025.

The purpose of this filing is update the usage-per-customer data to align with the most recent General Rate Case, UG-200994, and to include the cost of recalling 35,000 dekatherms per day (Dth/day) of the Company's Mist storage capacity from interstate/intrastate storage customers to core utility customers since our last general rate case by providing replacement tariff sheets as listed below, and to revise the proposed changes in the original cover letter. Page 2 of Exhibit A is being revised with this filing. Exhibit B remains unchanged from the September 15<sup>th</sup> filing.

## **Proposed Changes**

If there were no other adjustments to rates effective November 1, 2025, the average residential Schedule 2 customer using 56 therms would see an increase of \$0.01¹ per month, and the average Schedule 3 commercial customer using 236 therms would see a bill increase of \$0.03 per month. The average industrial customer on Schedule 42 firm sales using 12,869 therms would see a bill increase of \$0.62. The bill impact for customers on other rate schedules is shown on page 2 of Exhibit A to this filing. The rate changes would be an increase in the Company's revenues from its Washington operations of \$9,409, or 0.01%.

The proposed rate change will affect all of NW Natural's Washington sales customers. NW Natural currently serves approximately 91,114 residential customers and 7,387 commercial customers and 74 industrial customers in the Company's Washington service territory.
