

PARTIES OF RECORD. Each person who satisfies the requirements of rule for party status becomes a party of record and designates a representative who will receive communication about the proceeding. The name and mailing address of each such representative should be written on this form, along with the person's mailing address for receiving communication. Listed representatives should be sent copies of correspondence and orders.

IP Interested Persons are not parties of record but, through letter, appearance as a public witness in a railroad grade crossing or utility rate proceeding, or otherwise, have indicated that they desire to receive information about Commission action in the matter.

Individual service lists are still required where necessary to prove the fact and the date of service of individual items. Telephone numbers may be added, if available.

NOTE: The person with custody of the file or responsibility for the proceeding is responsible for seeing to the entry of changes or additions.
