Dear Mr. Rathbun:

This letter provides the 2005 annual report on the Critical Bond Program that was originally committed to in response to the WUTC Audit of Puget Sound Energy (PSE) Company's Central Division (UG-941394) and reaffirmed in the Settlement Agreement subsequent to the Pierce and King County Audits (PG-030080 and PG-030128.)

In 2005, PSE completed remediation on 93 CP systems for a cumulative total of 2,806 systems. The total number of CP systems increased from the original 2,701 to 3,511 in 2004. The total number of systems decreased to 3,305 in 2005. The number of systems changes when the existing systems are modified. Modifications include separating larger systems into smaller systems, combining systems, installing new systems and retiring existing systems. The attached table provides a summary of the number of systems completed for each year since the inception of the program.
