Re: TV-210351 – Issuing Permanent Household Goods Permit HG069802

Dear Zen Moving PLLP:

On May 21, 2021, Zen Moving PLLP, d/b/a Pure Moving; Man With a Truck Moving, filed an application with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) to provide residential household goods transportation services in the state of Washington. On July 15, 2021, the Commission approved the application in part and granted Zen Moving PLLP temporary authority to provide those services.

The Commission has determined that Zen Moving PLLP qualifies for permanent household goods carrier authority and approves the application in full. Permit HG069802 issued in the name of Zen Moving PLLP is enclosed, and the company may now operate on a permanent basis.

Zen Moving PLLP must continue to comply with state laws, Commission rules, and the provisions of Tariff 15-C. Failure to do so will result in Commission enforcement action, up to and including revocation of the company's permit.
