If you're going to choose this option, you need to show what you have done to shut down your business either completely or partially so that you're no longer advertising, offering, or providing unpermitted charter and excursion services in this state. For example, you're going to need to provide poof that you've taken down or changed your website or other online advertisements for your business.

Also, if you've applied for or obtained a certificate in advance of this hearing, please let me know, and in that case, we will not ask you to stop operating, but we will want you to acknowledge that you were operating without a permit and that you agree you will stop operating if your certificate is suspended or cancelled in the future for any reason.

Now, option B is to ask for a classification hearing. You choose option B if you believe that your business is not subject to regulation by the Commission. In other words, you're denying that you advertise, offer, or provide unpermitted charter and excursion

Depending on what proof you can provide, you may be given an opportunity to meet with Staff during the break in the hearing to negotiate an agreed cease and desist order.

If you have recently applied for or received a permit, you will also be given an opportunity to meet with Staff to negotiate an agreed order to resolve this matter. The agreed order will also deal with the penalty.

You were each served with a complaint that asked the Commission penalize you for engaging in business as a charter or excursion carrier without a permit. The law sets the maximum penalty at each violation at \$5,000. Staff will recommend a penalty and you'll have a chance to reach an agreement with Staff about the penalty amount. If you're unable to agree, Staff will explain the recommendation, but the Commission will make the final decision about the penalty amount.

Finally, if you choose option B, that is if you deny you're operating as a charter and excursion carrier, we will schedule another hearing like I discussed earlier.

If you choose option A, to testify about how you are getting out of the charter and excursion business, you can explain how you plan to do that.
