Avista submitted its tariff revision to its Schedule 175 "Decoupling" tariff on May 27, 2022 with a requested effective date of August 1, 2022. Recently, the Company's third party payment vendor has experienced issues which may limit its ability to mail the customer notice, via bill insert, to all customers that will be impacted by this filing prior to the requested August 1 effective date. In order to allow enough time to properly notice all customers, the Company respectfully requests to extend the effective date of this tariff filing to October 1, 2022. The Company plans to issue a revised customer notice during the August billing month in coordination with both the Schedules 92/192 (Low Income Rate Assistance Program), Schedule 191 (DSM) and Schedule 75 (Decoupling) tariff filings reflecting the proposed October 1, 2022 effective date.
