NOTICE SUSPENDING VERIZON'S COMPLIANCE FILING DEADLINE

RE: In the Matter of the Review of Unbundled Loop and Switching Rates and Review of the Deaveraged Zone Rate Structure

Docket No. UT-023003

TO ALL THE PARTIES:

On August 17, 2005, the Commission entered its 28th Supplemental Order in this proceeding, requiring Verizon to make its compliance filing in this case within 20 days of the date of the order. However, the Commission also required Verizon to notify the Commission within five business days of the order whether it needed additional cost estimates from the Commission to calculate compliance rates. *Order at fn.* 33.

On August 25, 2005, Verizon advised the Commission that the company required two additional interoffice facilities elements in order to make its compliance filing. Verizon also sought the Commission's advice regarding a rate element for reciprocal compensation.

The deadline for Verizon's compliance filing is September 6, 2005. The Commission expects to enter an order shortly providing the information Verizon seeks and establishing a new twenty-day compliance deadline. In the interim, the Commission suspends Verizon's current compliance filing deadline.

This is to notify the parties that Verizon's current compliance filing deadline of September 6, 2005 is suspended.
