- 5 3. Raymond Wright, Jr., P.E.


6 It is possible Union Pacific may need to substitute Raymond Wright with another  
 7 witness. Mr. Wright no longer works for HNTB. He now works for the City of Spokane. His  
 8 availability is currently unknown. If Mr. Wright is unable to attend the hearing, another engineer  
 9 from HNTB will familiarize himself or herself with Mr. Wright’s testimony and the engineering  
 10 and traffic study work on which Mr. Wright’s testimony was based and will be available at the  
 11 hearing to testify as to those studies and for cross-examination.

12 If it is confirmed at the pre-hearing conference that the hearing itself will last for two  
 13 days, I will ask that Lloyd Leathers be called to testify on Friday, October 20 instead of on  
 14 Thursday, October 19. The demands of his job are such that it will create a significant hardship  
 15 for him to attend the hearing on October 19; we would like to accommodate his preferred  
 16 schedule (to appear on October 20 instead) if at all possible.

17 Union Pacific will keep the WUTC and the parties advised as to the availability of Mr.  
 18 Wright.


