- 4. **PAYMENT:** The rental charge will be billed as such and is payable monthly in accordance with the company's regular billing schedule for gas service. (T)
- 5. **TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP:** Grand HVAC Leasing ("GHL") will acquire the Puget Sound Energy ("PSE") natural gas water heater rental service. GHL and PSE will collaborate on notifying Customers of the transaction and will provide Customers the option to 1) discontinue rental service and assume ownership of their rented water heater, or have their rented water heater equipment removed or 2) to continue rental service with GHL. The expected transition date is December 23, 2020, at which time Customers will no longer have rental charges on their PSE bill, but will be billed separately by GHL. Customers that do not discontinue their rental service prior to December 23, 2020 will transition to GHL. (N)
- 6. **DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE:** At 11:59 p.m. December 22, 2020, PSE will discontinue this service. After that time, all operation, maintenance, repair or replacement for the water heater will be the responsibility of GHL or the Customer, depending on the choice the Customer has made. PSE and GHL will implement a transition period, where Customers, can choose to 1) terminate their rental agreement under the existing PSE service terms and conditions and assume ownership of their rented water heater or have their rented water heater equipment removed, or 2) transition to rental service with GHL.
