TO ALL PARTIES:

On April 8, 2019, the CenturyLink companies<sup>1</sup> filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) revisions to their currently effective tariffs to discontinue private switch/automatic location identification services, currently described in the Emergency 9-1-1 service sections of the CenturyLink Companies' tariffs.

The Commission consolidated these dockets and suspended operation of the tariffs on April 25, 2019. On November 5, 2019, the Companies filed a motion to withdraw their respective tariff filings and dismiss the proceedings (Motion), stating that the Companies had no current intention to cease providing the services at issue.

On November 6, 2019, the Commission issued a notice suspending the procedural schedule in these dockets and authorizing any party to file a response to the Motion by 5 p.m., November 18, 2019.

On November 15, 2019, the Companies filed an Amended Motion to Withdraw Tariff Filing and Dismiss Proceeding (Amended Motion).

In order to give the parties time to formulate responses to the Amended Motion, the Commission finds good cause to extend the deadline to respond to the Amended Motion to 5 p.m. on November 22, 2019.

**THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That any party wanting to file a response to the Companies' Amended Motion must do so by 5 p.m. on November 22, 2019.**
