Dear Mr. Johnson:

On April 26, 2018, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("Commission") entered both Order 07 in Dockets UE-170485 and UG-170486 and Order 02 in Dockets UE-171221 and UG-171222, Final Order Rejecting Tariff Sheets, Approving Partial Settlement, and Directing Company to File Tariff Sheets in Compliance with this Order (collectively, "Final Order"). The Final Order authorized the Commission Secretary to approve by letter, with copies to all parties, a filing that complies with the requirements of the Final Order. On April 27, 2018, Avista Corporation ("Avista" or "Company") filed revisions to its tariff sheets, which are effective on May 1, 2018.

Commission Staff has reviewed Avista's revised tariff sheets and believes that they comply with the terms of the Final Order. Staff's review was limited to verifying that the tariffs contain the revenue requirement calculation ordered by the Commission and that the calculation is properly reflected in the electric and gas tariff sheets provided by the Company. Due to severe time constraints, Staff was not able to verify whether other schedules related to rider revenues were captured appropriately in rates nor to review any textual changes to the revised tariffs. A table of the tariff sheet revisions the Company submitted is attached to this letter.
