Regarding PSE's response to Staff Data Request 113. When did PSE first conduct this analysis comparing SAIDI and SAIFI for highly impacted communities and vulnerable populations relative to the general customer base?

**Response:**

Puget Sound Energy ("PSE") calculated System Average Interruption Duration Index and System Average Interruption Frequency Index for highly impacted communities and vulnerable populations for the first time in September 2021. This followed the completion of the Integrated Resource Plan analysis, which first identified specific highly impacted communities and vulnerable populations within PSE's service territory.
