Re: UT-090842 – Joint Application of Verizon Communications Inc. and Frontier Communications Corporation for an Order Declining to Assert Jurisdiction Over, or, in the Alternative, Approving the Indirect Transfer of Control of Verizon Northwest Inc.

Dear Mr. Danner:

On April 16, 2010, the Washington State Utilities and Transportation Commission (“WUTC”) issued a Final Order in the above-referenced matter. In the Settlement Agreement with Staff of the WUTC (“Staff”), Frontier Communications Northwest (“Frontier”) agreed to submit an initial plan for broadband deployment and to consult with Staff regarding the geographic scope and timelines for implementation (Settlement paragraph 17). Frontier met with and consulted with Staff on September 23, 2010 regarding its broadband deployment and submitted its broadband deployment plan to the WUTC records center on September 28, 2010. In response to requests by Staff, Frontier is filing an explanation of its methodology for developing household counts, which will be used going forward. This information contains proprietary information, and is being filed in both a Highly Confidential and a Public redacted version in accordance with the Protective Order in the above-referenced docket.

Staff also requested an explanation of the listings of Everett wire centers as provided by Verizon during the discovery process prior to the July 1, 2010 closing of the Verizon-Frontier transaction, and what Frontier provided in the broadband plan. The Everett Main and Everett Chennault listings provided by Verizon are in one wire center. The second listing is a remote location originally installed for provision of ISDN service, but is treated as part of the Main wire center.
