On April 5, 2011, TracFone Wireless, Inc. (“TracFone”) provided the Commission with customer records related to its SafeLink Wireless<sup>®</sup> Lifeline service for calendar year 2010 for filing in the above-referenced docket. TracFone filed these records in compliance with the Commission’s order designating the company as an eligible telecommunications carrier. The customer records, which were provided on an encrypted computer disk, are designated as confidential pursuant to WAC 480-07-160, because the disk contains valuable commercial information regarding the customers subscribing to TracFone’s service. The disk includes each customer’s name, Department of Social and Health Services identification number, last four digits of the Social Security Number, and date of birth. TracFone and its customers would be directly and adversely affected by disclosure of the confidential information. Moreover, disclosure of the information contained on the disk would violate customers’ privacy rights. The password for the disk is: **[REDACTED]**.
