**NOTICE ESTABLISHING DEADLINE FOR CUSTOMER NOTICE  
(Deadline for Filing Customer Notice July 23, 2010)**

RE: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Company*, Docket UE-100749

TO ALL PARTIES OF RECORD:

On June 17, 2009, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 04, *Prehearing Conference Order*. That Order, among other things, established a procedural schedule including a deadline of July 2, 2010, for Public Counsel to file a status report regarding its efforts to reach consensus with PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Company (PacifiCorp) and Commission Staff (Staff) regarding the format and content of any public notice PacifiCorp is required to issue in connection with these proceedings.

On July 1, 2010, Public Counsel filed a status report indicating that representatives of Public Counsel, PacifiCorp, and Staff had been conferring regarding the public notice but had not yet completed discussions. Public Counsel requested that a new status report date be set for July 23, 2010.

The Commission finds that Public Counsel stated good cause for extending the time to file the customer notice in this case. However, if the parties are unable to reach consensus, PacifiCorp must file, by July 23, 2010, a customer notice that complies with the requirements of WAC 480-100-194.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That the deadline for filing a customer notice is July 23, 2010.**
