**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO RESPOND TO  
PETITIONS FOR RECONSIDERATION,  
COVAD'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME, AND  
COVAD'S MOTION TO STRIKE**

TO PARTIES OF RECORD:

On March 22, 2002, Qwest and AT&T both filed Petitions for Reconsideration of the Twenty-Eighth Supplemental Order in this proceeding. Pursuant to WAC 480-09-810(4), any party wishing to respond to the petitions for reconsideration must do so by the close of business, **Friday, April 5, 2002.**

On March 20, 2002, Covad Communications Company (Covad) filed a Motion for Extension for Time to File Comments on Qwest's Change Management Process. Covad's motion is granted. Responses to Qwest's Change Management Process are due no later than 5 p.m., **Monday, April 8, 2002**, and Qwest's rebuttal filing is due no later than 5 p.m., **Monday, April 15, 2002.**

Finally, on Monday, March 25, 2002, Covad filed a Motion to Strike the Testimony of Robert L. Stright filed by Qwest on March 15, 2002. In order to address the matter during the prehearing conference scheduled for April 2, 2002, all responses to Covad's motion must be filed with the Commission no later than **Noon, Monday, April 1, 2002.**
