RE: Standards for Interconnection to Electric Utility Delivery Systems,  
WAC 480-108, Docket UE-060649

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) is pleased to enclose rules in WAC 480-108, relating to Electric Companies—Interconnection with Electric Generators developed from the rulemaking activity in Docket UE-060649.

The rules in WAC 480-108 requires electrical companies under the Commission's jurisdiction to offer interconnection service for customer-owned generation facilities up to a generation capacity of 20 megawatts and specify the terms, conditions and qualifications governing such service.

Also enclosed is the Commission's Order Amending and Adopting Rules Permanently. The Commission filed the Order with the Code Reviser on September 27, 2007. It will be effective on October 28, 2007.

RCW 34.05.325 requires that the Commission prepare and provide to commenters a concise explanatory statement about an adopted rule.

In this docket, to avoid unnecessary duplications, the Commission has designated the discussion in the order as its concise explanatory statement, supplemented where not inconsistent by the adoption hearing memoranda. Together, the documents provide a complete but concise explanation of the agency's actions and its reasons for taking those actions. We include all of those documents for commenters' information.
