RE: *Washington Utils. and Transp. Comm'n v. Avista Corp. d/b/a Avista Util.*,
Dockets UE-220053, UG-220054, and UE-210854 (*Consolidated*)

TO ALL PARTIES:

On December 12, 2022, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Final Order 10/04 (Order 10/4), which among other things, required Avista Corporation d/b/a Avista Utilities (Avista or Company) to submit a Compliance Filing outlining how it is incorporating equity into all stages of its Capital Planning process.¹

On December 20, 2024, Avista filed with the Commission its Equitable Business Planning Framework. The Company's filing provides a detailed overview of the Company's efforts to integrate equity into all aspects of its Capital Planning in compliance with the Order 10/04.

On January 13, 2025, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that Staff has reviewed the Company's compliance filing and believes that it contains sufficient detail with respect to detailing its equitable business processes regarding Capital Planning, and, therefore, complies with the requirements set forth in Order 10/4.

The Commission agrees that Avista's December 20, 2024, compliance filing of the Equitable Business Planning Framework complies with Order 10/4.
