Dear ALJ Clark:

This letter will serve as a motion on behalf of Iliad Water Services, Inc. (“Iliad”) to file a late filed exhibit in this docket.<sup>1</sup> In this proceeding, Iliad stated that Mr. McDonnell, the company’s engineer, had informed it that Iliad, as a for-profit company, would not qualify for Department of Health Safe Drinking Water Revolving Fund funding. Then, Staff filed an exhibit, Exhibit 73, which apparently bore Mr. McDonnell’s signature on a Safe Drinking Water Revolving Fund application for Y Bar S, ostensibly a for-profit corporation. In Staff’s brief, Staff implied that Mr. McDonnell’s reported statements could not possibly be consistent.

Although it is not an earthshaking issue insofar as the hearing in this matter is concerned, because an individual’s reputation is at stake, Iliad is seeking to file the attached late filed exhibit which shows the basis upon which the Y Bar S application was signed by Mr. McDonnell. It shows that Mr. McDonnell was consistent in his view that a for-profit corporation would not qualify for funding.


