4 **Q. Please state your name and business address.**

5 A. My name is Lorin I. Molander. My business address is 10885 NE Fourth Street,
6 P.O. Box 97034, Bellevue WA 98009-9734.

7 **Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?**

8 A. I am employed by Puget Sound Energy, Inc. (“PSE” or “the Company”) as a
9 Regulatory Consultant in Pricing & Cost of Service.

10 **Q. What are your duties as a Regulatory Consultant in Pricing & Cost of**
11 **Service for PSE?**

12 A. I am responsible for PSE's load research function primarily supporting the cost of
13 service. I manage or perform a variety of customer-related analyses including the
14 calculation of hourly demands by customer class, weather normalization, and bill
15 impacts of rate proposals.

1 **Q. Briefly describe your education and other relevant employment experience.**

2 A. I hold a Bachelor of Science degree in Economics from the University of Puget
3 Sound. I have 15 years of experience, mostly in the energy/utility industry, in the
4 field of customer data analysis with respect to load research, forecasting, market
5 research, and energy efficiency program planning, design, and evaluation.

6 Prior to joining PSE's Pricing & Cost of Service group in 2003, I was employed
7 by Volt Services Group from 2001 to 2003 as a Consultant to PSE to develop the
8 Company's extensive customer billing system data warehouse used to conduct a
9 wide variety of customer analyses including rates and billing analyses.

10 From 2000 to 2001, I was the corporate Sales Forecaster for on-line grocery
11 retailer HomeGrocer.com, where I oversaw the development of econometric
12 models pertaining to customer acquisition and retention for current and potential
13 markets.

14 From 1997 to 2000, I was employed by PSE in the Market Research &
15 Forecasting group as a market researcher responsible for the Company's load
16 research function.

17 From 1994 to 1997, I held the positions of analyst, senior analyst, and consultant
18 for Quantum Consulting Inc., a nationally recognized energy consulting firm that
19 provided consulting services relating to energy efficiency and demand response
20 program evaluation, planning and design, and market research.
