Dear Mr. Danner:

Pursuant to WAC 480-100-393 and in compliance with Order 17 of consolidated Docket Nos. UE-072300 and UG-072301 ("Order 17"), Puget Sound Energy ("PSE") files with the Commission its revised Electric Service Reliability Monitoring and Reporting Plan (the "Plan"). WAC 480-100-393(2) requires that any modification to an electric service reliability monitoring and reporting plan be filed with the Commission prior to the implementation of the modification. Order 17 set forth that PSE should file the modification within 10 business days of the effective date of Order 17, November 29, 2010, and authorized PSE to combine all the required annual Service Quality Index ("SQI") program reporting and electric reliability reporting into one report to facilitate external review.

The Plan outlines the electric service reliability section of the combined PSE SQI and electric reliability annual report for the performance years 2010 and after. The proposed Plan is designed to meet the specific reporting requirements of WAC 480-100-398, Electric service reliability reports, and the additional reliability reporting requirement prescribed in Order 12 ("Order 12") of the aforementioned 2007 dockets. The reporting format and content is also consistent with the Electric Service Reliability Reports that PSE has been filing with the Commission since 2005, but have been modified to improve readability. SQI measurements not related to SAIDI and SAIFI are not subject to the requirements of WAC 480-100-393; therefore the outline for the SQI section of the combined report is not included in this filing.

On December 1, 2010, PSE sent the Plan to the representatives of the Public Counsel Section of the Washington Office of Attorney General and to the Commission's

regulatory staff ("Staff") for their input per PSE's commitment prescribed in Section F of Appendix D of Order 12. PSE had incorporated Staff's input into this Plan.
