

Per the requirement of Administrative Law Judge Adam Torem in his December 10 Notice, on behalf of the intervenors the undersigned represents in the proceeding, this is to note by way of an individual status report that the Commission's solid waste rule making in TG-080591 may be highly relevant to the resolution of the remaining issues in this proceeding. As the Commission is aware, the staff recently circulated a draft rule on March 11, 2009 which addresses definitional sections in WAC 480-70-016 and, when finalized, may again resolve the remaining legal issues in this proceeding. We therefore recommend that the Commission or the Office of Administrative Hearings schedule a telephone status conference with the parties possibly later in the summer to update and coordinate the potential for implementation of new rules in this industry and to otherwise maintain orderly processing of the pending complaint hearing.
