RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Puget Sound Energy, Inc., Dockets UE-072300 and UG-072301 (consolidated)

TO ALL PARTIES:

On November 29, 2010, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered its Order 17 Granting PSE's Petition For Approval of Modifications to its Service Quality Index Program, in consolidated Dockets UE-072300 and UG-072301. The order requires that Puget Sound Energy (PSE) make compliance filings updating Appendices 1 and 2 to Exhibit J in the Twelfth Supplemental Order in Dockets UE-011570 and UG-011571 to reflect SQI reporting and mechanics changes approved in Orders 1 and 2 of Docket UE-031946, Orders 12, 14, and 16 in consolidated Dockets UE-072300 and UG-072301, and all the changes approved by the Order within 20 business days after the effective date of the order. The order also authorized the Commission's Executive Director and Secretary to approve the authorized filing by letter if it complied with the terms of the order.

On December 27, 2010, PSE filed updated Appendices 1 and 2 to Exhibit J in the Twelfth Supplemental Order in consolidated Dockets UE-011570 and UG-011571. The Commission has examined the above filings and they appear to comply with the terms of the order.

Therefore, pursuant to terms of the Commission's Order 17 in this proceeding, the updated Appendices 1 and 2 to Exhibit J in the Twelfth Supplemental Order filed by PSE are determined to be in compliance with Order 17.
