II. FINDINGS

1 Enforcement of Orders Pending Judicial Review, (5) the declaration of Armikka Bryant in  
2 Support of Dolly's Motion to Stay, and (6) the arguments of counsel.

3 Based on the pleadings, evidence, and arguments presented, the Court finds:

- 4 1. The Commission's ~~Corrected Order 02 and Order 04~~ are based on public health,  
5 safety, and welfare grounds.  
6 2. Dolly has failed to carry its burden of showing all the criteria for a stay found in  
7 RCW 34.05.550(3).

8 I. ORDER

9 Based on the above findings, IT IS ORDERED:


10 Defendant's motion to dismiss is Denied. *without prejudice,*
