Do the natural gas conservation savings estimates that are the basis for the conservation phase-in adjustment reflect increased usage from fuel-switching customers who discontinued use of an electric appliance and replaced such appliance with a natural gas appliance?

Response:

No. Puget Sound Energy, Inc.'s ("PSE's") did not have a fuel conversion program during the 2008 test year in PSE's current general rate case. As such, PSE-sponsored electric-to-natural gas fuel conversion does not affect the natural gas conservation savings used to calculate PSE's conservation phase-in adjustment in this case.
