TO ALL PARTIES:

The Commission entered its Thirtieth Supplemental Order in this docket on October 26, 2005. The order, among other things, required Verizon to revise its tariffs to reflect the exclusion of rates for 2- and 4-wire feeder subloops and dark fiber loops and subloops.¹ The order required the tariff revision to be filed within 30 days of the completion of the compliance phase of this proceeding.

On November 21, 2005, the commission entered its Thirty-First Supplemental Order approving Verizon's revised compliance filing Advice 3160.

On March 28, 2006, Verizon filed revised tariff revisions to include the 4-Wire rates that was inadvertently excluded in it November 21 filing, and to make minor housekeeping changes. The tariff revisions are attached to this letter. Verizon requested that the tariff revisions become effective April 27, 2006.

The commission has reviewed these tariff revisions and finds them in compliance with the terms of its orders.

Therefore, pursuant to the terms of the Thirtieth Supplemental Order, the tariff sheets attached to this letter will become effective as filed on April 27, 2006.
