Waste Management agrees with the report filed on behalf of Staff, and shares the belief that the current solid waste rulemaking could resolve the remaining issues in this case, and determine when a commercial recycler may collected mixed recyclable material without a certificate of convenience and necessity, and when it is illegally performing unauthorized solid waste collection. *See* Docket TG-080591.

Ironically, today is the deadline for written comments on the discussion draft rule that was published on March 11. Waste Management concurs with Staff's request that the procedural schedule in this matter remain suspended and that the Commission should schedule a further status conference in three to four months to determine whether the rule is proceeding in a manner that would resolve the remaining issues in this case.
