- Consistency with work paper filing requirements in WAC 480-07-520 (Summit)
- Require delivery, rather than receipt, of email to comply with deadlines (Summit)

WAC 480-07-150 Service of documents in adjudicative proceedings

- Define results if no express consent to electronic service (PSE)
- Delete reference to electronic return receipts (PSE)
- Require both electronic and paper service with waiver option for both party and UTC service (ICNU)
- Clarify when UTC will serve electronically (Summit)
- No electronic service of complaints, which should be served on registered agent (Summit)

WAC 480-07-160 Confidential information under RCW 80.04.095 & RCW 81.77.210

- Retain reference to other kinds of confidential information (PSE, Summit)
- Reconcile number of hard copies of redacted document (CL, PC)
- Encryption of confidential information in electronic documents (PPL)
- Exempt work papers from marking requirements (PPL)
- Establish procedure for designating highly confidential information (ICNU)
- Applicability of section 141 to deficiencies with confidential submission (Summit)
- Clarify effect of deficient confidential submission (Summit)
- Allow time for discussion to respond to request without producing confidential information before 10 day notice given to provider (Summit)

WAC 480-07-175 Inspection and production of documents in commission investigations

• Require reasonable notice of review without undue disruption of business or unduly burdensome production of copies (Summit, WK)
