UE-072300 and UG-072301 Order 12 ("Order"); Puget Sound Energy ("PSE") submits an original and twelve copies of PSE's Meter and Billing Performance Quarterly Filing for the period ended June 30, 2011.

This filing addresses requirements set forth in the Order and is in accordance with additional detailed terms prescribed in the Settlement Stipulation. For this reporting period, the filing includes the Meter and Billing Performance Quarterly Report that details the following:
