Dockets UE-220053, UG-220054, and UE-210854 (*Consolidated*)

TO ALL PARTIES:

On December 12, 2022, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 10/04 in Dockets UE-220053, UG-220054, and UE-210854 (Consolidated). Order 10/4 was the final order issued by the Commission in the 2022 general rate case (GRC) filed by Avista Corporation d/b/a Avista Utilities (Avista). Order 10/04, among other things, required Avista to report certain performance metrics for each year of the rate plan approved in the 2022 GRC.

On April 30, 2025, Avista filed with the Commission its Report on Performance Metrics for 2024, the second rate-year approved in the 2022 GRC.

On June 11, 2025, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that Staff has reviewed the Company's compliance filing and believes that it contains sufficient detail with respect to performance metrics, and, therefore, complies with the requirements set forth in Order 10/4.

The Commission agrees that Avista's April 30, 2025, compliance filing complies with Order 10/4.
