Dear Mr. Cramer:

By this letter, the Commission acknowledges receipt of the Motion for Modification of Temporary Permit you filed on August 3, 2000, on behalf of Joseph Dean Smith, d/b/a Joe the Mover. In reviewing this matter, the Commission has discovered a clerical error in the permit issued to your client, which was inadvertently served in a form slightly different from that required in the order.

We are enclosing for your client an amended temporary certificate to correct this error. After examining the corrected certificate, you may wish to file an amended motion for the relief your client seeks. If you do not wish to amend the petition, please advise the Commission.

Because the motion seeks to remove a condition from the certificate, the Commission will docket the motion with the Commission's Records Center, will assign a formal docket number and will distribute it to the appropriate staff.

If we receive by August 15 the amended motion or request to process the existing motion as filed, the Commission will publish the motion on the Commission's Application Docket for Monday, August 21st. The publication will allow any interested person to comment on the motion within 15 days. We expect that the matter will be scheduled for hearing as a brief adjudicative proceeding under RCW 34.05.482-.494, and WAC 480-09-500. This letter provides notice to Commission Staff of the opportunity to respond to the motion on the deadline that is established in the Application Docket.

The Commission identifies this schedule as a means to provide a speedy resolution of your motion while affording the opportunity to interested persons to respond.
