

In Docket UW-041384, Rainier View Water Company, Inc. filed to put a conservation rate in place. We are providing you with specific notice that the conservation rate will apply to your service, even though you are receiving an "irrigation only" type of service.

Rainier View wants to be sure that there is no confusion among those that are receiving service for irrigation purposes only. The conservation rate will apply to anyone that uses water in excess of 3000 cubic feet in a billing period. The proposed rate is \$5.00 per 100 cubic feet in excess of 3000 cubic feet in a billing period.
