On April 24, 2007, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) assessed a penalty of \$500 against Meridian Transportation Resources, LLC d/b/a MTR Western (MTR Western) for one violation of 49 CFR § 382.301(a), which requires companies to ensure each driver receives a negative pre-employment controlled substances test result.
