REVISED PROJECT AGREEMENT GRADE CROSSING PROTECTIVE FUND

A. PARTIES OF THE AGREEMENT

This project grant agreement (agreement) is entered into between the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC), P.O. Box 47250, Olympia, Washington 98504-7250 and Washington State Parks and Recreation Commission, and shall be binding upon the agents and all persons acting by or through the parties.

B. PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT

This agreement sets out the terms and conditions by which grants are made from the Grade Crossing Protective Fund. These grants are administered by the UTC to the grantee for Docket No. TR-071945, identified above.

C. DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT

TR-071945 involves a proposal by the grantee for the second phase of a three-phase pedestrian bridge project at Larrabee State Park. The second phase involves design and permitting and will include bridge type, site and location design study and detailed geotechnical investigations to begin permitting and stakeholder review. The completed project will provide a pedestrian bridge across the existing BNSF Railway mainline tracks and construct a gravel pathway for access to Clayton Beach at the park.

D. PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE

The project reimbursement period shall begin on December 27, 2007, and end December 30, 2008. No expenditure made before or after this period is eligible for reimbursement unless incorporated by written amendment into this agreement.

E. PROJECT FUNDING

Total grant funding awarded by the UTC for these projects shall not exceed \$50,000.

F. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS

All rights and obligations of the parties to this agreement are subject to this agreement and its attachments, including the grantee's application, commission orders, and the general provisions, all of which are attached and incorporated into this agreement.

Except as provided, no alteration of any of the terms or conditions of this agreement will be effective unless provided in writing. All alterations must be signed by both parties.

The grantee has read, fully understands and agrees to be bound by all terms and conditions in these documents.

G. <u>COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE STATUTES</u>, <u>RULES</u>, <u>AND UTC POLICIES</u>
This agreement is governed by, and the grantee shall comply with, all applicable state and federal laws and regulations, including RCW 81.53.281, the published agency rules in 480-62 WAC, and the commission's order in this matter which are incorporated by this reference as if fully set forth.
