Dear Ms. Phillips:

On June 16, 2008, CenturyTel of Cowiche, Inc. and CenturyTel of Inter Island, Inc., (collectively CenturyTel), filed a joint request for approval of first amendments to the Interconnection and Traffic Exchange Agreements (amendments) between CenturyTel and 360networks (USA), inc., (360networks), in Dockets UT-073054 and UT-073055. The amendments are delegated items scheduled for approval by September 10, 2008.

The amendments are four days late. The commission reserves the right to investigate, and if appropriate, commence a separate proceeding to complain, enforce, and penalize CenturyTel for failure to meet the filing requirements of Section 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996. WAC 480-07-640 (effective January 1, 2004) requires interconnection agreements be filed for approval within 30 days after the agreement is signed. A similar letter has been sent to 360networks.
