Docket TV-100387; Application for Permanent Authority

On March 5, 2010, First Due LLC, d/b/a First Due Moving & Delivery; First Due Movers, filed Docket TV-100387 requesting permanent household goods authority.

The commission granted the company temporary authority subject to conditions pending a decision on its application for permanent authority. The company has operated under Household Goods Carrier permit THG-63862, since March 22, 2010.

Under WAC 480-15-330, the commission will grant or deny an application for permanent authority after conducting a complete review of the application filings, supporting statements, reports, or other information necessary to determine fitness, public interest, and current or future public convenience and necessity.

Compliance staff worked with the company providing technical assistance during its temporary operations. Investigator Richard Smith completed a Safety Compliance Review, a Household Goods Technical Assistance and Records Review Checklist. Investigator Smith found the company in general compliance and on June 15, 2011, he recommended the applicant be considered for permanent authority.

The current provisional permit THG-63862 is in order as follows:

- o Records Center has the annual report on file for 2010.
- o Financial Services reports the company has paid appropriate regulatory fees.
- o The commission does not have any outstanding penalty or other fine against THG-63862.
- o Consumer Affairs does not have a pending consumer complaint.
- o Transportation Safety does not have a pending compliance action.

I recommend the commission grant TV-100387 without hearing and reissue permit THG-63862 to HG-63862, First Due LLC, d/b/a First Due Moving & Delivery; First Due Movers, as unrestricted permanent authority to operate as a household goods carrier in the state of Washington.
