
COMMISSION STAFF'S RESPONSE

1 Pursuant to WAC 480-07-370(1)(c), Staff of the Washington Utilities and  
Transportation Commission (Commission Staff) submits this response<sup>1</sup> to Helping Hands  
Moving Company's Application for Mitigation.

2 On June 30, 2010, the Commission assessed a penalty of \$100 against Helping  
Hands Moving Company's (Helping Hands) for violating WAC 480-15-480. Helping  
Hands filed an amended Application for Mitigation on July 21, 2010. Commission Staff  
opposes Helping Hands' Application for Mitigation for the reasons set forth in the attached  
declaration of Sheri Hoyt.
