
As you are aware, on July 30, 2012, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Collier Technologies, LLC in the amount of \$ 2,100 for violation of WAC 480-120-382, which requires competitively classified telecommunications companies to file an annual report with the Commission by May 1 each year. Collier Technologies, LLC did not file its 2011 annual report by May 31, 2012, which is 21 business days past the deadline. On December 28, 2012, in response to a request for mitigation, the Commission issued Order 01: Order Granting Mitigation on Condition, mitigating the penalty to \$525. Collier Technologies, LLC submitted a payment of only \$100. The Commission sent Collier Technologies, LLC a Corrected Invoice on January 7, 2013, a Second Notice on February 8, 2013, and a Final Invoice on March 13, 2013.

The Commission has not received the \$425 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$425 balance.
